Using the construction paper given to you in class, draw the first letter of your Spanish name and the first letter of your last name and connect them together. **YOU MUST GET APPROVAL FROM SRA. BEFORE YOU CUT OUT YOUR LETTERS.**

You will decorate your letters with pictures (magazine, hand drawn, computer generated, etc.) to represent the following:
